- I. Watch "Straight Talk about Sexual Choices and Consequences" presented by Marsh Media
 - a. Description of video:

Featuring a show within a show, this title is designed to help young people resolve important growing up issues. After a brief overview of the male and female reproductive systems, the host ask students to think about the responsibility of decision-making: discussing STDs, pregnancy, what makes a healthy relationships, and more. They provide valuable insights to real-life problems, helping boys and girls to react responsibly.
 - b. Discuss video and respectful relationships

- II. Sexually Transmitted/Pregnancy PowerPoint
 - a. Discuss most common sexually transmitted diseases
 - i. Chlamydia
 - ii. Gonorrhea
 - iii. Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV)
 - iv. Human Papilloma Virus/Genital Warts
 - v. Herpes

- III. Transmission of STDs
 - a. Sexual contact – not just sexual intercourse
 - b. Bloodborne transmission

- IV. Pregnancy, labor, and children
 - a. Unintentional consequence of intercourse
 - b. Lifestyle changes with children
 - c. Importance of abstinence
